

## **Circular Economy Policy**



## **Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to **establish the commitments to advance a fair and sustainable energy transition based on the Circular Economy**, as part of the solution to the global challenges of our Society, such as: resource scarcity, waste management, climate change, biodiversity loss and environmental deterioration.

## **Our Commitments**

- Promote Circular Economy by keeping materials in circulation for as long as possible taking advantage of the potential resources contained in waste and reducing the need to extract new materials replacing (part of) them.
- Promote industrial symbiosis between facilities, companies, administrations, academic institutions and civil society by encouraging the exchange of raw materials, services and products (such as water and steam).
- Promote reintegration of waste into the value chain, avoiding elimination when possible, prioritizing recovery.
- Promote efficient management of resources, including water, favoring regeneration, recycling, reuse and withdrawal reduction.
- Promote and drive initiatives in Circular Economy by establishing and monitoring objectives as well as identifying opportunities for improvement.

- Promote research and innovation in sustainable alternatives to conventional raw materials, as well as in the design and implementation of clean production that optimize the use of resources, emissions and impacts on nature.
- Promote circular alternatives for materials resulting from the modification or closure of our activities.
- Promote responsible consumption through the choice of suppliers and the acquisition of products or services, considering their environmental impact.
- Contribute to the creation and sharing of knowledge about circular economy transition sharing good practices and innovative solutions.

## **Scope of Application**

This Policy applies to Moeve, the Group's subsidiaries where effective control is exercised, their directors and employees, and to third parties with whom there are legal relationships and who have adhered to it.

Additionally, persons acting as representatives of the Group in companies and entities not belonging to the Group, or where our Company does not have effective control, shall promote, to the extent possible, the implementation of principles and guidelines consistent with those set forth in this Policy.

The current version of this Policy has been approved by the Moeve Board of Directors on Dec 5, 2024 and is effective from the moment of its approval.
